## UNIX/LINUX INSTALL

1. If upgrading, please ensure that you have 2 complete backups prior to starting.
2. Insert the Power Accounting CD into the CD ROM drive.
3. Log in as the root user, by-passing any menus.
4. Type **umask 000** from the operating system prompt.
5. Mount the CD by using one of the following commands:

```
mount /dev/cd0 /cdrom      < SCO
mount /dev/hdc /mnt/cdrom  < Linux
mount -F cdfs -r /dev/chrom/cdrom1
/cdrom1                   < Unixware
```

Please check out our website at <http://www.samco.com/faqs/19.3.htm> for an up-to-date list of possible Unix and Linux commands for mounting CD ROM drives.

6. Change into the mount directory by typing **cd /cdrom** or **cd /mnt/cdrom**
7. Start the update / install routine by typing **sh ./install** or **sh ./dginstall** for **Data General users**
8. Select **I** for a new installation or **U** for an upgrade.
9. Carefully read the License Agreement and, when complete, press **F2** to accept.
10. Enter the directory where you want Power Accounting installed (**/u/ssi/** or **/usr/ssi** is recommended), and follow the screen instructions.
11. When prompted, indicate that this is an install from **CD** by accepting the default of **1**.
12. Confirm the mount directory of your CD-ROM drive (usually **/cdrom** or **/mnt/cdrom**).
13. Enter in the Installation Kit runtime serial number and activation key (**IK**) provided with

this package. Continue on by following the screen instructions.

14. From the list, select the packages to be installed onto your system. We highly recommend not installing any modules you are not licensed for at this time. Press **TAB** when all desired packages have been selected.

\*Please note that although you are not limited to those packages you have licenses for, we recommend not installing any demo modules at this point. At a later date please either refer to the instructions posted on our *Knowledgebase* at [www.samco.com](http://www.samco.com) or ask a **Help Desk rep** for further details on adding demo modules.

15. For upgrades, when prompted, answer **Y** to upgrade all of your company data.
16. If applicable, enter in the serial numbers and activation keys for all of the packages you are installing.
17. From the operating system prompt type:

```
umount /cdrom            < SCO
umount /mnt/cdrom       < Linux

umount /cdrom           < Unixware
```

18. The Version 6.7 install/upgrade is now complete.
19. Change into the install directory by typing **cd /usr/ssi** or **cd /u/ssi** (replace with your directory name) and type in:

```
sh ./setperms
```

20. To start up Samco's Power Accounting system, change into the install directory and type **./MENU**. Please refer to the *System Functions* manual for detailed set up instructions.

# WINDOWS INSTALL

1. Please disable Norton Utilities or any other anti-virus software you may have running as it interferes with the creation of icons.
2. If upgrading, please ensure that you have 2 complete backups prior to starting.
3. Insert the Power Accounting CD into the CD-ROM drive. If the installation routine does not start automatically, select **Start → Run** from the Window's task bar and type in **D:\SETUP** (replace the **D:** in the command with the drive letter of your CD-ROM).
4. Select **I** for a new installation or **U** for an upgrade.
5. Carefully read the License Agreement and, when complete, press **F2** to accept.
6. Enter the directory where you want Power Accounting installed (**C:\SSI is the norm and recommended**), and follow the screen instructions.
7. When prompted, indicate that this is an install or upgrade from **CD** by accepting the default of **1**.
8. Confirm or change the drive letter of your CD-ROM drive.
9. Enter in the Installation Kit runtime serial number and activation key (**IK**) provided with this package. Continue on by following the screen instructions.
10. From the list, select the packages to be installed onto your system. We highly recommend not installing any modules you are not licensed for at this time. Press **TAB** when all desired packages have been selected.
